CONDITIONS

EQUIPMENT

- Tables: Blue Tihbar Smash
- Nets: Tihbar
- Ball: Butterfly 40mm Orange 3 Star

RULES

- All matches shall be played under the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ

ELIGIBILITY

- Only registered members of TTNZ and players affiliated to ITTF member countries are eligible. TTNZ members **must** quote their membership number on their entry form.
- Eligibility for age-group events is determined by age as at 31st December **last** for all **Under age events** and as at 31st December **next** for all **Over age events**. Proof of age may be required.
- B Grade: Men and Women – Rating lower than 25 on TTNZ Rating list as at Day Date Year
- C Grade: Men lower than 100 and Women lower than 60 on TTNZ rating list as at Day Date Year

ENTRIES

- Entries must be accompanied by the correct fees. Entries accompanied by the **correct fees and received** by the ??? Day Date Year will be eligible for the **10% discount**.
- The Association reserves the right to refuse any entry and to vary restrictions at its discretion.
- Both players in any doubles pairing must submit separate individual entries for the same doubles event.

DRAWS

- Any event with less than 4 singles entries or 3 doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of the association. Players so affected will be entered in the next lower age category if they are not already in that category.
- The right is reserved to make alterations to any draw.
- We will use Group play for all singles events. Either one or two players will qualify from each group for the Knock-out stage.
- Only the Men's and Women's Singles Knock-out stage will be best of 7 advantage games up to 11 points. All other events and groups will be best of 5 advantage games up to 11 points.

DRUGS

- The New Zealand Sports Drug Agency reserves the right to conduct random drug testing.

GLUING

- No gluing shall be permitted inside the stadium other than within areas designated for the purpose.

AUTHORITY

- The Tournament Manager reserves the right to vary these conditions, and to exercise control over all activities within the stadium and adjacent areas. This includes the right to default players who fail to respond when called to the table within the published or announced playing session times.
- The Referee and delegated assistants reserve the right to apply and enforce the Laws and International Regulations of Table Tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ. Their interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.

CLOTHING

- Non Marking sports shoes must be worn
- No caps or other head gear is allowed to be worn
- No orange coloured clothing can be worn as we are using orange table tennis balls
- No jeans or other inappropriate clothing is allowed to be worn
- The Referee is the sole judge as to what is appropriate clothing

Canteen

- Refreshments and light food would be available from the canteen

NOTE

Players may enter a maximum of 3 singles events and 5 events in total on either day.
