EQUIPMENT:

- ❑ Tables: Up To 10 Butterfly Tables Available For Play.
- ❑ Nets: Up To 10 Tibhar Nets Fitted To Tables.
- ❑ Ball: Butterfly or 729 3 Star Balls (White).

ELIGIBILITY:

- ❑ Only registered members of TTNZ and players affiliated to ITTF member countries are eligible. TTNZ members must quote their membership number on their entry form.
- ❑ Age category eligibility is determined by age as at 31.12.2006. Proof of age may be required.

TEAM EVENTS

- ❑ Team events will be conducted in the following categories: Men & Women's Over 40s, 50s, 60s, and 70s.
- ❑ All team events will use the round robin format.
- ❑ Each team comprises two players.
- ❑ Individuals may enter the team events with any partner from within their own Association provided their partner qualifies under "Eligibility" above.
- ❑ Players without a team may enter partner required and WTTA will place you into a team under the draft system. Each player may compete in only one team category.
- ❑ **Note:** Separate teams event medals will be awarded to players of the Northern Regional Round Robin

ENTRIES:

- ❑ Envelopes containing entries must be postmarked no later than the closing date and arrive at WTTA no later than one day after the scheduled closing date.
- ❑ The correct fees must accompany entries. WTTA reserves the right to impose a penalty for late payments. Fees are refundable if advice of a withdrawal is received by WTTA at least one day prior to the tournament date.
- ❑ No player may enter more than two age group singles events, one from the 9:10 time slot and one from the 12:30 time slot. A player may also enter two only doubles events. WTTA reserves the right to refuse any entry and to vary restrictions at its discretion.
- ❑ Both players in any doubles pairing must submit separate individual entries for the same doubles event.
- ❑ Any entrant wishing to receive acknowledgement of receipt of their entry form must enclose a stamped addressed envelope, or provide a return email address. Otherwise entries will be processed without acknowledgement.
- ❑ Players may not wear white shirts during tournament play.

DRAWS:

- ❑ For the open age group singles events all players will be placed into a four person round robin; first two qualify for knockout main draw, remaining two go into knockout plate event. Full singles guidelines are contained in Section 4 of the TTNZ Handbook, which can be reviewed on the TTNZ web site.
- ❑ For doubles events seeded knock out draws shall be conducted except where less than six pairs have entered. The round robin format may then be used.
- ❑ Any event with less than 4 entries or three doubles pairs may be cancelled at the discretion of WTTA. Player affected will be entered in the next lower age category if they are not already in that category.
- ❑ WTTA reserves the right to make alterations to any draw.

MATCHES:

- ❑ All matches shall be best of five advantage games to 11.

DRUGS:

- ❑ The New Zealand Sports Drug Agency reserves the right to conduct random drug testing

GLUING:

- ❑ No gluing shall be permitted inside the stadium other than within areas designated for the purpose.

AUTHORITY:

- ❑ The tournament manager and or controller reserve the right to vary these conditions, with the agreement of WTTA liaison officer, and to exercise control over all activities within the stadium and adjacent areas. This includes the right to default players who fail to respond when called to the table within the published or announced playing session times.
- ❑ The referee and delegated assistants reserve the right to apply and enforce the laws and International Regulations of table tennis as adopted by the ITTF and TTNZ. Their interpretation of these laws and regulations is final.
